We look forward to communicating with you throughout construction and beyond!

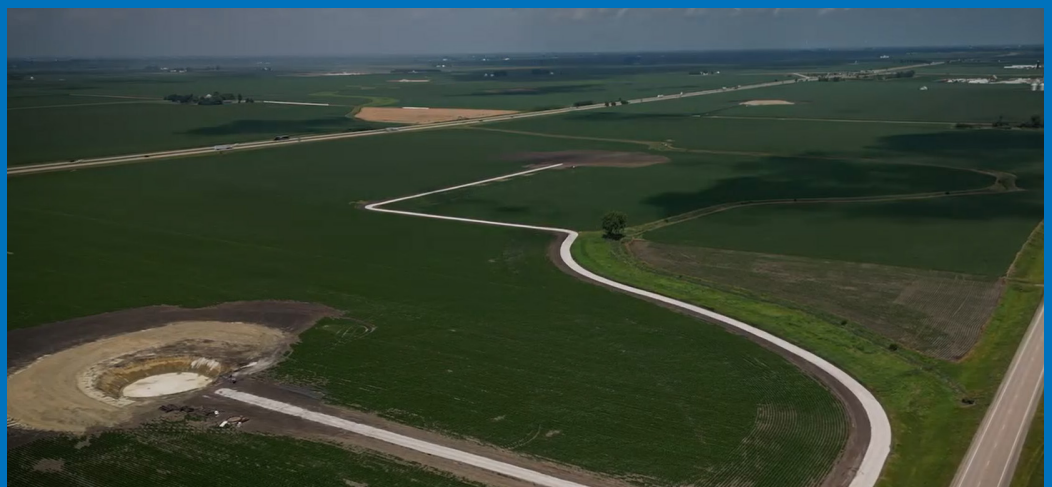

 - Central Illinois Agency on Aging

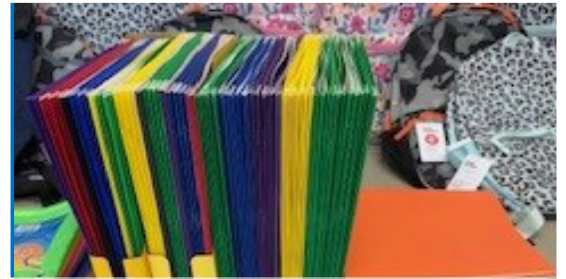
PG1 Construction Underway

Construction activity is ramping up across the Panther Grove 1 site. The first turbine in Minonk has officially been erected—a major project milestone—while crews are actively preparing the remaining turbine locations. In addition, locally owned, construction industry leader Dunn Company from Decatur has been providing road development and soil stabilization services on the PG1 site. Their work enables us to build durable access routes to the turbine sites while upgrading local county roads.
